Developing fragility functions for tsunami damage estimation using numerical model and post - tsunami data from Banda Aceh, Indonesia

Fragility functions, as new measures for estimating structural damage and casualties due to tsunami attack, are developed by an integrated approach using numerical modeling of tsunami inundation and GIS analysis of post-tsunami survey data of the 2004 Sumatra-Andaman earthquake tsunami disaster, obtained from Banda Aceh, Indonesia. The fragility functions are expressed as the damage probabilities of structures or death ratio with regard to the hydrodynamic features of tsunami inundation flow, such as inundation depth, current velocity and hydrodynamic force. They lead to the new understandings of the relationship between local vulnerability and tsunami hazard in a quantitative manner

OCHA situation update no 2 : Gaua island volcanic activity, Vanuatu ; 08 December 2009

OCHA situation update 2. 08/12/09. The volcanic activity on Gaua Island is continuing at low to moderate while the Vanuatu Volcano Alert remains at level 2. Mt Garret volcano on Gaua Island, Torba Province has had a series of activity since September, 2009 until a more significant eruption on 18 November, 2009. Mt Garet had remained

quiet for the last 27 years. According to the assessment done by scientists from New Zealand, activity from the active summit crater is characterized by the alternating steam and gas emissions which feed acid rain and semi continuous ash emissions creating ashfalls down wind. Level 2 requires on island evacuation mainly from the West to the East as well as the population around the Waterfall which is closer to the lava path. However level 3 would require evacuation of the whole island
