Fiji Tropical Cyclone Mick situation report no. 2. 14th December 2009, 1400hrs - 1800hrs, NDMO, Suva. The Special Weather Bulletin number six issued from the RSMC Nadi at 1.14 am on Monday, 14th of December, 2009 showed that Tropical Cyclone Gale Warning remains in force for Vanua Levu, Taveuni, Viti Levu, Yasawa and Mamanuca, Lomai Viti Group and nearby smaller islands. The cyclone is moving South East at 20 kilometers per hour (10knots) and on its current track the cyclone centre is expected to lie about 140 km to the North Northwest of Nadi. Destructive winds will begin a few hours before the centre passes
