Medics hunt for cause of deaths

Thursday, May 27, 2010. Two people have died as an outbreak of shigellosis hit Wainunu and Kubulau districts in Bua. Divisional medical officer Northern Dr Samuela Korovou confirmed that two teams of health officials were conducting case investigations in the areas to determine the source of the outbreak. Dr Korovou said shigellosis, which induces dysentery or passing blood, stained faeces and high fever is caused by oral faecal route transmission like typhoid

Economic valuation of climate change adaptation in developing countries. Annals of the New York Academy of Sciences

Reviews the literature on the economics of climate change adaptation in developing countries, and identifies three key points for consideration in future studies. All development policy should be formulated using forecasts from climate science as a baseline, authors must be clearer about their behavioural assumptions and the allocation of rights is crucial for the results; if households have a right to maintain their current livelihoods, the costs of climate

change in developing countries are considerably greater than traditional willingness-to-pay studies would indicate. Thus, costs and benefits of climate change adaptation cannot be analyzed using economic aspects only; climate science, behavioural science, and legal and moral aspects have crucial implications for the outcome of the analysis

Pacific submarine volcano issues 'big burp'

1/06/2010. A rapid Pacific submarine volcano eruption has exhaled a steam and ash cloud in the air and left a trail of debris on the surface of the water near Sarigan Island in the Northern Mariana Islands, U.S. officials said. Game McGimsey, a volcanologist for the U.S. Geological Survey, said the vent, lying 1,000 feet under the surface, issued a cloud 40,000 reaching feet in the air. The current volcano alert level is advisory, and the current aviation colour code is yellow, meaning volcanic activity has decreased significantly but continues to be closely monitored for possible renewed increase

Major quake shakes Vanuatu

28/05/2010. A 7.2 earthquake struck off Vanuatu on Friday, seismologists said, sparking a tsunami warning which was later cancelled. The quake hit at 04:14 (17:14 GMT on Thursday) at a depth of 36km, 214km northwest of Luganville, or 2 070km northeast of Brisbane, Australia, according to the US Geological Survey. The Pacific Tsunami Warning Centre issued a tsunami warning for areas of the South Pacific including the Solomon Islands, Vanuatu and New Caledonia

Vanuatu volcano causes disruption

1/06/2010. Volcanic activity in Vanuatu has disrupted flights, closed tourist areas and seen people evacuated from their homes. The Wellington Volcanic Ash Advisory says Vanuatu's Mount Yasur sent ash 1800m high and spread over about 340 square kilometres, affecting flights in neighbouring New Caledonia. Mount Yasur has been erupting

for months but in the last week has become more active. "Yasur volcano is currently undergoing moderate to large eruption with strong explosions ejecting volcanic bombs a bulletin from the Department of Geology, Mines and Water Resources Geo-Hazard Section said. Director of the National Disaster Office Job Esau told Radio Vanuatu most garden crops have been damaged or covered with ash
