The Yellow Bird ALERT : emergency warning dissemination in rapidly-evolving natural disasters

Presentation of the Yellow Bird ALERT System at the 16th Regional Disaster Managers Meeting, 9th - 11th August 2010, Holiday Inn, Suva, Fiji. Highlights how early warning can be beneficial, in times of disasters. Details of how Yellow Bird Alert would be able to disseminate messages in emergency. The Yellow Bird ALERT uses a tone from a radio to "wakeup" a battery-operated radio, which then activates a flashing light and a loud alarm sound to alert all in the vicinity that an emergency warning is to be broadcast

The 'Yellow Bird' A.L.E.R.T. system (Automatic Link to Emergency Radio Transmissions)

The Yellow Bird ALERT is a standard radio modified with a chip allowing remote triggering in times of a rapidly evolving emergency (bushfire, tsunami, cyclone, storm, etc). It allows emergency services agencies to disseminate emergency warnings to radio networks, which in turn broadcast an audible triggering tone that "turns on" individual radios to receive broadcast emergency warnings. Since this is an audible triggering tone, using either the ABC's emergency warning, "jingle" theme or the Standard Emergency Warning Signal (SEWS), it is platform-independent and can be used with AM, FM, indeed any band, broadcast in either analog or digital formats

Summary report of the Pacific delegation : Global Platform for Disaster Risk Reduction ; second Session, Geneva, Switzerland, 16 - 19 June 2009

The 2nd Session of the Global Platform for Disaster Risk Reduction provided an opportunity for a broad range of partners to assess progress made in disaster risk reduction since the First Session in 2007 and to increase commitment and measurable actions to implement - nationally and locally. The Pacific Delegation at the 2009 GP: The UNISDR Sub-Regional Office for the Pacific convened Suva-based partners coordinated with Pacific Island representatives to prepare for the Global Platform in early 2009. Based on the experience from the first session of the GP in 2007, it was recommended that a larger delegation should attend the next GP to be able to (1) profit from the learning opportunities at the GP/DRR; (2) cover the large spectrum of sessions and presentations; and (3) filter these back to the region.
