

Many disaster-response buildings lie in tsunami zones

Daily Yomiuri News, 3 September 2011. More than 60 percent of municipalities located in Pacific coastal areas that are at risk of being hit by major earthquakes have disaster management and evacuation facilities located in areas expected to be inundated by tsunami, a Yomiuri Shimbun survey has found. The survey was conducted in 197 municipalities in 17 prefectures, from the Kanto to Kyushu regions that are expected to be affected by tsunami triggered by Tokai, Tonankai and Nankai earthquakes. These quakes are predicted to occur sometime in the near future, possibly simultaneously. According to survey results, 127 municipalities, or 64 percent of those surveyed, had public facilities such as municipal government offices, police stations and schools located in areas that are expected to be submerged by tsunami
