## What is the difference between CCCM & the Emergency Shelter cluster?

### ‘SOFTWARE’

- CCCM deals with the know how, the people and organizational aspects of establishing, running and closing of camps.

### ‘HARDWARE’

- Technical standards and guidelines are not part of CCCM
- Shelter provides technical guidelines to CCCM and reconstruction projects (as wat/san, health, etc.)

- Camp Coordination (in natural disasters – IOM would take the lead)
- Camp Management

What are 3-5 main response gaps or priority activities addressed by this cluster **in the field?**

- Improve living conditions, assistance to and protection of IDPs living in camps.
- Advocate for durable solutions to be found as quickly as possible.
- Effective common policy framework guiding humanitarian actors.
- Consistency and common standards applied in all camps.
- Secure humanitarian space and unhindered access for delivery of humanitarian services.
- Ensure involvement of residents in camp governance structures.
- Mainstreaming of cross-cutting issues.

## Key Things To Know

- ✓ CCCM Cluster does not promote camps but sees camps as a last resort.
- ✓ CCCM is a “new concept” to provide better protection and assistance to camp (camp-based) populations
- ✓ Camps, sites, settlements, transitional shelters, collective centres all fall under CCCM. And the cluster can be called anything as long as the principles are applied.
- ✓ CCCM supports finding durable solutions
